## What else has happened so far, and what can I do?

Bedford Borough Council has already started a review of the wider Local Plan (covering the period up to 2032) to determine the overall levels of housing and other development needs to be accommodated in the Borough during the plan period.

This has included a call for development sites from landowners. Responses from Stevington are available to view on the Council website and are shown on a map displayed here today.

The Neighbourhood Plan would set out whether our community would like this land to be developed and how - such as where new homes and businesses should be built and what they should look like. It can set out the appropriate type and amount of development, so long as it fits within the wider planning framework.

Take a look at the posters that show the 6 topics most commonly covered in Neighbourhood Plans. Consider what you value about the village, what you want to protect, but also what you don't like, what could be improved and what's missing... and tell us what you think.
